1. Preparation

- Before beginning assembly, compare parts with package contents list to make sure all are present. If any part is missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble the product.
- Determine the desired height and spacing of the wall lights • and mark the positioning of the lights to be installed.
- Required tools: power drill / 1/4" drill bit / Phillips Head screw driver / hammer

2. Installation

- From the transformer (sold separately) run the wire from an outlet across the distance where the lights will be installed.
- At the location of each light, measure and mark for two mounting holes 2 inches apart.

- Using a 1/4" drill bit, drill into the wall siding and tap in the included plastic anchors (D) with a hammer. * Screw mounting screws (C) into anchors leaving the screw head approximately 1/4" from the wall surface.
- Place the light housing above the mounting screws and slide downward into place.
- Secure the Connector Clip (B) to the power pack wire, as shown above.
- Test the connection by turning on the lights. Make any desired adjustments.
- Complete the install by digging a small trench, inserting the transformer wire and back filling the trench with dirt.

* NOTE: if mounting lights to a brick surface, you may need to use masonary screws (not included).

CARE AND CLEANING

Before Cleaning, Disconnect the power to the fixture by unplugging the fixture.

Clean the fixture with a soft damp cloth.

Do not use any cleaners with chemicals, solvents or harsh abrasives.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution			
The fixture will not light.	There is no power. There is a disconnect or break in the wire.	Check the outlet and ensure that a breaker or GFCI circuit has not been tripped.			
	The transformer setting is incorrect.	Follow the wires from the fixture and ensure continuity back to the transformer. Check the settings on the transformer.			
		CHECK THE SECTINGS OF THE CHAINSTOFFIEL.			
The light flickers (one only)	There is a loose connection to the fixture.	Repair the loose connection and ensure proper contact.			
The lights flicker (all)	There is a loose connection at the transformer.	Unplug the transformer from the outlet and visually inspect the positive and negative connecting points. Each wire should securely be screwed in and ot contact with each other.
