GRADING CRITERIA

Typically, character grade will include both heartwood and sapwood and allows a wider range of colour variation. Knots are larger and you should expect checks (cracks across the growth ring). The colour of the filler is intended to complement the natural structure of the wood, where features such as knots are in contrast to the surrounding timber, and it may vary from batch to batch.

N.B. The product grading criteria is inspected at each mill visually and should be taken as an approximation only. Please ask for further details
