

More than 1,100 hand-cut spruce wood panels line the walls of Greece's Wooden Cave hotel, located 3,600 feet above sea level off the slopes of the country's Mount Kyllini. Each suite is split in half design-wise. The rear-half is primarily made of curved wood and is made to feel like a protective outer shell - similar to the walls of a cave.
