Timeless, classic and longlasting - a staple of American interiors. Rich grain patterns. Easy to work with and takes stain and finish well.




POP - POPLAR

Versatile wood with consistent texture. Its natural color varies and may change over time. Stains, paints and finishes extremely well.




SP - STAINABLE PINE


CASING

Casings define the overall character of a room and are often the most visible part of the trim. They are used primarily to cover the gap between drywall and the door or window frame.



CROWN

Crowns are placed along the wall at the ceiling. They come in a wide range of patterns and sizes. Crowns soften the transition from wall to ceiling while adding a distrinctive look and charm.







Baseboards are placed along the wall at the floor. They should be chosen to work in harmony with your casings to finish and tie the room together. Baseboards could be thinner than the casing.

































COVE





CHAIR RAIL



Chair rail is a type of moulding that is used in the middle of a wall. Originally, chair rail molding was installed in dining rooms at about chair height to protect the walls from being damaged by the backs of chairs.





BED MOULD

Bed moulding is a type of trim used to cover the joint between the wall and ceiling.

OUTSIDE CORDER

Outside corner moulding is cut at a 45-degree angle and juts out towards the room.



MANTLE MOULD

Mantle mould is commonly used as a decorative moulding on walls, tops of doors and windows, and fireplace mantles.

For windows, stop moulding is used to stop sashes that swing in or out.

T-ASTRAGAL

T-Astragal moulding is installed with double or French doors. It keeps the second door from swinging through the opening.

STOOL

The window stool is the part of the window that is visible and commonly called the window sill.

CAP

A base cap is a decorative wood profile applied to the top of a baseboard to create an attractive, elegant look.





SCREEN & SHELF

A very versatile profile, screen mould fits a wide variety of needs and uses.

Screen mouldings are traditionally used to hold mesh screening into wood screens, they also work well as edge trim on various shelving or wood trim for wallpaper.


BACK BAND

Back band moulding is a type of trim that's typically installed alongside baseboards or door and window casings.

Backband moulding adds thickness to existing moulding and trim and instantly boosts the architectural interest.
