# **Spinal Cord Injury SCI**

## **Signs and Symptoms**

- Pain and tenderness over spine
- Numbness or Paraesthesia
- Weakness or heaviness of limbs
- Paradoxical resperations
- Priaprism (sustained erection)
- · Deformity of spine
- Altered skin sensation (tingling)
- Paralysis of limbs
- Nausea

#### Warning

All head injuries should be considered spinal cord injuries until proven otherwise

#### **First Aid**

This position is termed the High Arm IN Endangered Spine or HAINES position



Logrolling is a maneuver used to move a patient without flexing the spinal column.



### Management

#### **Unconscious patient**

- DRSABCD
- · Prevent flexion or rotation of head
- Maintain neutral head position
- Place unconscious patient in Haines position (single operator)
- Manual inline support and log roll (2 rescuer)
- Airway always takes precedence over spine injury
- Call emergency services '000' and follow instructions

#### **Conscious patient**

- DRSABCD
- Patient to remain calm and not move (on ground)
- Patient to be placed on ground at own accord (if standing)
- Maintain neutral head position (manual inline support)
- · Airway monitored at all times
- · Place patient on rigid backboard
- Call emergency services '000' and follow instructions
