

How to find your Fivetran MAR consumption

Fivetran meters usage in Monthly Active Rows (MAR). There are two common ways to check how much MAR your account has consumed: through the Billing & Usage page in the Fivetran dashboard, or programmatically by querying logs surfaced through the Fivetran Platform Connector.

Option 1 — Billing & Usage page (UI)

- Account members assigned the Account Administrator or Account Billing role can open the Usage tab on [Fivetran's Billing & Usage page](#) to view overall account consumption and usage details.
- Role assignments and other account-level controls are documented in Fivetran's [account settings documentation](#).

Option 2 — Fivetran Platform Connector (programmatic)

For teams that want to compute MAR directly against the underlying log data — for example, to break usage down by connector, schema, or time window. Fivetran exposes its platform logs through a dedicated connector.

- Configure the [Fivetran Platform Connector](#) following Fivetran's setup guide.
- Run the MAR calculations from Fivetran's [sample query library](#) against the synced log tables.
