Packing List

Please pack all items in a duffel bag, suitcase, or backpack. Be sure to label ALL items with campers' name.

- Bible
- Alarm Clock
- Fan
- Sleeping Bag (if you prefer sheets, you'll need XL Twin Sheets)
- Pillow and Pillow Case
- Shirts
- Shorts/Pants
- Sweatshirt or Jacket
- Pajamas
- Socks and Underwear
- Tennis Shoes
- Flip Flops/Sandals
- Rain Gear
- Bath Towels & washcloths
- Toiletries and Shower Caddy (Shampoo, Toothpaste, Toothbrush, Deodorant, Soap, Feminine products, etc.)

- Comb/brush
- Shower Shoes
- Sunscreen
- Bug Spray
- Sunglasses/Hat/Sun Visor
- Water bottle
- Clothes that can get dirty
- Beach towel, and swimsuit (females will need to have a shirt to wear over, not white)
- Glasses or Contacts and solution if needed

Keep in mind when packing that your camper will be responsible for carrying their own luggage.

What you can bring for Theme Nights: (optional, but encouraged. There will be awards for best dressed):

'Merica Night: Bring red, white, and blue clothing or accessories, camouflage, plaid, cowboy boots, etc.

Tropical Night: Bring straw hats, Hawaiian shirts, grass skirts, sunglasses, etc.

80's Night: Bring bright colors, headbands, eyeshadow, ripped jeans, etc.

Do you have Medication?

Our Amplify Nurse will take all medications when you register the day of camp. Please bring medication in its original bottles along with medical release form.

What should NOT be brought to camp:

Pets

Matches, Lighters, or Candles

Alcohol

Tobacco Products or Electronic Cigarettes

Illegal drugs and paraphernalia

Weapons (pocket knife included)

Outside food or snacks: Due to multiple food allergies, we are not allowing food to be brought in by campers. Any outside food will be confiscated. There will be a buffet for each meal and multiple snacks provided throughout each day. Thank you for helping us keep campers safe.

Electronics: Phones, iPods, laptops, gaming devices, etc. Yes! That's right CELL PHONES WILL NOT be allowed at Amplify. However, if you are uncomfortable with your child being without a phone, your child can bring an old school flip phone to be approved at check in.
