

## Kingdom Equations

### Big Idea

You are never too great to serve someone. In fact, Jesus reminds us throughout His ministry that the greatest will be servants. When we build a life of service, there is nothing “below” us!

### Let's Talk

1. **Service.** Service is how we express love with our actions. When we serve others, we are showing that we value other people and that our actions can make a difference in this world. Is there a time recently when you did something for someone else without the need to be repaid? Have you served someone without the need for praise or recognition?

*“By this, all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.” John 13:35*

2. **Humility.** Throughout the life and ministry of Jesus, we see Him living in a way that shows great humility. He could have had all the riches in the world with the snap of a finger, but so often we see Jesus giving up his place of prominence for the good of someone else. It was the model of his life and the way of his death and resurrection. While we are not Jesus, we are called to represent Him to our world and live a life *like* Christ. Are you putting others before you? What could you do this week to respond with humility?

*“... For the one who is least among all of you, this is the one who is great.” Luke 9:48b*

### Reflect & Respond

Are you making an impact with your life? We all have one life to live, and the way we serve and love others will create the Kingdom impact that we might have. There is no shortcut to serve; it takes time and humility to serve someone. Be on the lookout this week for opportunities to care for someone else.
