# **WEEK 3 | OLDER PRESCHOOL**

Need to Know: God Helps Me

Bible Story: God Feeds the Israelites

Bible Reference: Exodus 16-17



### **CIRCLE UP**

DO

- Welcome kids to church and tell them who you are.
- Sanitize kids' hands. Then allow each child to have a turn rolling the pocket dice.
- Show the Pocket Dice Card the dice lands on and have kids pretend to put on that piece of western wear.

SAY

Good job, buckaroos! Just like you helped all of us know your names, God wants you to know that He is with you and will always help you!

Let me hear you say that after me: (Pause to allow kids to repeat after you)

God (both hands point up)

Helps Me (reach out, palms up)

### **READ THE BIBLE**

Po Read the Bible Story Cards aloud to the group.

SAY

- When the people were hungry, did God give them boots for their feet or food to eat? (Food to eat)
- You got it! And when they were thirsty, did God give His people a mountain to climb or water to drink? (Water to drink)
- That's right! When Moses and God's people needed help, they asked God to help them. And what did God do — did He gallop away or help them? (He helped them)
- Yessiree! When you need help, you can remember that God will help you, too!

#### LET'S PRACTICE

DO

- Give each child one Western Coloring Sheet.
- Show each **Leader Card**, and allow kids to respond. Then give each child one **star sticker** to place in the appropriate place on their Western Coloring Sheets.
- Continue until all Leader Cards have been shown/read and all stickers have been placed on Sheets.

SAY

God has a good plan for you and me, and He will always help us! Say this after me: (Allow kids to repeat)

God (both hands point up)

Helps Me (reach out, palms up)

## **LET'S PRAY**

SAY

Hey God! Thank You for helping us. We will ask You for help every day! We love You! In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.

## **MEMORIZE IT**

SAY & DO

There's a verse in the Bible that tells us God loves us and has a good plan for you and me. Let's practice it now. Repeat after me: (Pause to allow kids to say each line)

"God is (both hands point up)

always at work (pound fists on top of each other)

for the good of everyone (two thumbs up)

who loves Him." (hug self)

Romans 8:28 (make book with hands)

DO

- Have kids pop up and down as they say the verse.
  - For example: (Pop UP) "God is, (Pop DOWN) always at work, (Pop UP) for the good, (Pop DOWN) of everyone, (Pop UP) who loves Him." (Pop DOWN) Romans 8:28
- Sanitize kids' hands again, and place crayons in the center of the group. Allow kids to color the front and back of their Western Coloring Sheets.
