Need to Know: God Helps Me Bible Story: God Feeds the Israelites Bible Reference: Exodus 16-17



 Welcome kids to church and tell them who you are. Sanitize kids' hands. Then allow each child to have a turn reaching in the mystery bag to select an eraser as they share their name with the group. Have kids do the following based on which eraser is selected: Star - Reach up to touch the stars Boot - Pat your feet Hat - Shake your head all around 	
Good job, buckaroos! Thank you for helping us have fun and get to know you! Today, God wants you to know that He will always help you! Let me hear you say that after me: (Pause to allow kids to repeat after you) God (both hands point up) Helps Me (reach out, palms up)	
READ THE BIBLE	
Read the Bible Story Cards aloud to the group.	

- SAY
- When the people were hungry, did God give them boots for their feet or food to eat? (Food to eat)
 - You got it! And when they were thirsty, did God give His people a mountain to climb or water to drink? (Water to drink)
 - That's right! When Moses and God's people needed help, they asked God to help them. And what did God do did He gallop away or help them? (Help them)
 - Yessiree! When you need help, you can remember that God will help you, too!

LET'S PRACTICE

DO 3 2 1	 Place pie pans in a row in the center of the group. (See example on the left) Sanitize kids' hands, and allow each child to toss the pom pom onto a pie pan. Read <u>one</u> question from the Leader Guide that corresponds with the pie pan that the pom pom landed on or is closest to. Continue playing until each child has a turn. Then collect all materials.
SAY	God loves you, and He wants to help you every day! Say this after me: (Allow kids to repeat) God (both hands point up) Helps Me (reach out, palms up)
LET'S PRAY	
SAY	Hey God! Thank You for helping us! Please show us how we can help others. We love You! In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.
	MEMORIZE IT
SAY & DO	There's a verse in the Bible that tells us God loves us and has a good plan for you and me. Let's practice now. Repeat after me: (Pause to allow kids to say each line) "God is (both hands point up) always at work (pound fists on top of each other) for the good of everyone (two thumbs up) who loves Him." (hug self) Romans 8:28 (make book with hands)
DO	 Have kids pop up and down as they say the verse. For example: (Pop UP) "God is, (Pop DOWN) always at work, (Pop UP) for the good, (Pop DOWN) of everyone, (Pop UP) who loves Him." (Pop DOWN) Romans 8:28 Sanitize kids' hands again, and place crayons in the center of the group. Allow kids to color the front and back of their Coloring Sheets.
