Week 3	Demonstrative and relative pronouns; orientation in time; numbers, past tense; conversational part; biography
Week 4	Prepositions; introduction to cases; conversational part
Week 5	Adjectives; declension of nouns and adjectives of the neuter gender; declension of nouns and adjectives of the feminine gender
Week 6	Modal verbs; future tense; comparation of adjectives; conversational part

Week 7	Conditional and imperative; conditional future tense;
	sentence structure and conjunctions; conversational part
Week 8	Overall revision and test
