- You'll need to know
 - How billers interact with payers like **Medicare** and **Medicaid**
 - The different types of insurance
 - Including the different types of managed care and how they interact with billers and providers
 - How to format and transmit claims
 - **HIPAA regulations** and billing guidelines
 - Case analysis questions, much like those on the **CPC Exam**, will provide a hypothetical scenario, and billers must use that scenario to answer a single or set of questions
