

TREND: IMPACTFUL OFFICES IN A SMALLER FOOTPRINT





Far from disappearing, the private office now offers new levels of support for specific governmental functions.



TREND: POWER AND POSTURE MAKE COLLABORATION MORE EFFECTIVE




