Congratulations on your new HON Screens! Designed to help create physical space separation, we know great things will come from your new workspace.

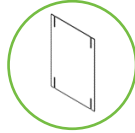
Tools Needed:



(x1) Rubber Mallet



(x2) Gloves



(x2) Large Acrylic Panels,
(x2) Small Acrylic Panels



(x6) Connector Blocks,
(x6) Gaskets, (x3) Top Caps

Now that you have your Tools and Materials - Let's Get Started!

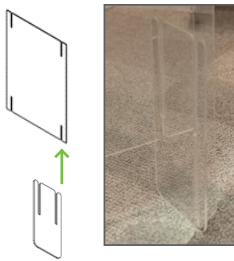

Steps to Assemble:

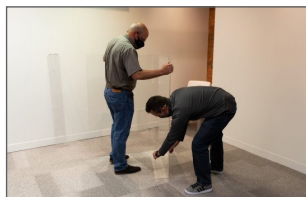
- 1 Slide 1 slot of the connector block into the bottom slot of a large acrylic panel.**



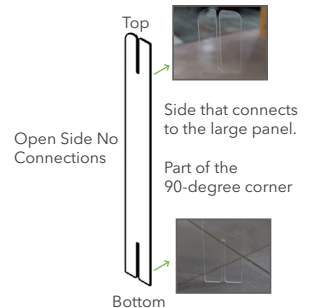
- 2 Slide second large panel into the open connector block already installed in the first large panel.** Create a 90-degree angle with the 2 large panels, slide a second connector block into the slots at the top of the large panels.



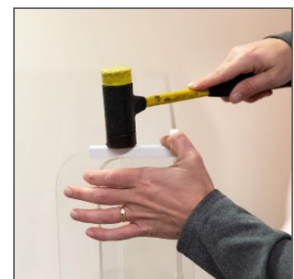
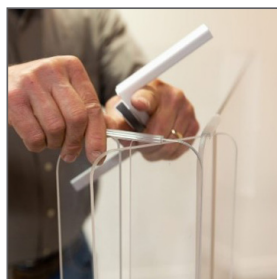
- 3 Tilt the large panels upward to lift one corner.** Add connector block to the slot at the bottom of the large panel. Set the screen flat on the floor.



- 4 Place a small acrylic wing panel into the open slot on the connector block.** Add a second connector block to connect the large panel to the wing panel. Repeat this step on the other side for the second wing panel.



- 5 Place 2 gaskets at each 90-degree top corner.** Extend the gasket just beyond the slot for added stability. Add top cap to each corner and tap downward using a small rubber mallet.
