

Routine Cleaning

Spot clean with upholstery shampoo, foam from a mild detergent, or mild dry cleaning solvent. Pretest a small, inconspicuous area before proceeding. Do not saturate. Hot water extraction or steam cleaning is not a recommended cleaning method. Cushion casings should not be removed and laundered or dry-cleaned. To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming or light brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to remove dust and grime is recommended. When cleaning a spill, blot immediately to remove spilled material. Clean spots or stains from the outside to the middle of the affected area to prevent circling.

Use a professional cleaning service when an overall soiled condition has been reached.

Disinfecting

Fabric can be disinfected using a dilute bleach/water solution (1:10) or EPA-registered sodium hypochlorite disinfectant. After application, use a cloth moistened with water to remove the surface bleach.

An EPA-approved quaternary cleaning/disinfectant chemical can be used when applied according to the product manufacturer's cleaning/dilution directions.
