RE: Allsteel Inc. request for price adjustment for Region 4 Furniture, Installation and Related Services Contract R191802

Dear Mr. Zingelmann:

As we continue to face global supply chain disruptions, nationwide labor shortages, and substantial inflationary pressures, Allsteel remains focused on controlling costs, maintaining core product availability, and furnishing the industry's best product lines at the most competitive prices to you.

- The Consumer Price Index has increased 1.25% to 4% over the past 10 months.
- Industrial metals are nearing record highs, increasing ~200% from early 2020.
- Since July 2020, cold roll steel has increased more than 230%.
- Aluminum has increased 49% in the last 12 months.
- Global transport capacity is 30% less than 2019 levels.
- Job openings continue to increase while the workforce as a whole continues to be impacted by COVID cases, childcare, early retirements, and increased wage demands.

Due to the immediate and significant pressures we are facing, we are required to take immediate action. Allsteel Inc. is formally requesting a price adjustment effective November 22, 2021, based on its November 2021 price lists. We will honor a 30-day grace period for orders previously quoted prior to that date. Allsteel will implement an 11% commercial list price adjustment to furniture product lines and architectural product lines, including previously approved specifically engineered products, which applies equally to all products. Allsteel will also implement a freight adjustment to \$0.54 per mile to architectural product lines.

Additionally, effective November 22, 2021, Allsteel will implement a flat 2.5% surcharge in addition to the invoice total as a direct result of the increasing fuel and ocean freight inflation.

- The World Container Index has increased 300% over prior year.
- Diesel prices have increased +50% over prior year to the highest price since November 2014.



In addition, we request to update the Gunlocke pricing to their November 2021 price lists effective November 22, 2021. The Gunlocke price adjustment is 11% and the 2.5% surcharge will also apply. Likewise, HBF will implement a 7% surcharge effective on November 22, 2021.

Overall, we remain focused on assuring our pricing practices allow us to compete successfully in the market.

Thank you for your continued business and opportunity to provide Region 4 customers quality Allsteel, Gunlocke, and HBF products.
