With stationary or mobile pedestals in slim and wide configurations and units that mount below the worksurface, Radii allows people to organize and store their most essential items within easy reach. Undermount units travel up and down with height-adjustable tables and even offer optional power for device charging. Radii work tools are utilized within and on storage units to organize items, and can move to the desktop for easy access. When used in a height-adjustable table, benching, or desking application, Radii effectively utilizes every inch of the footprint with a soft, rounded-corner design.

Radii addresses the need for workers to stow, rather than store, in a compact, space-efficient design that allows them to stay productive and connected to their work. The open undermount and caddy offer an open-concept design when a lock isn't needed.

Radii allows for easy cleaning and it's hard surface is bleach cleanable for disinfecting.

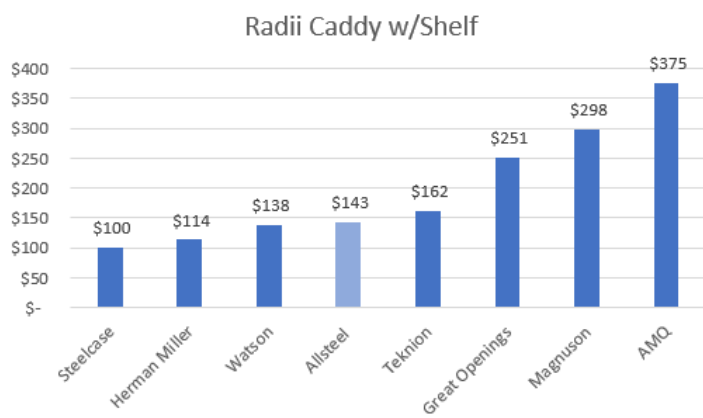
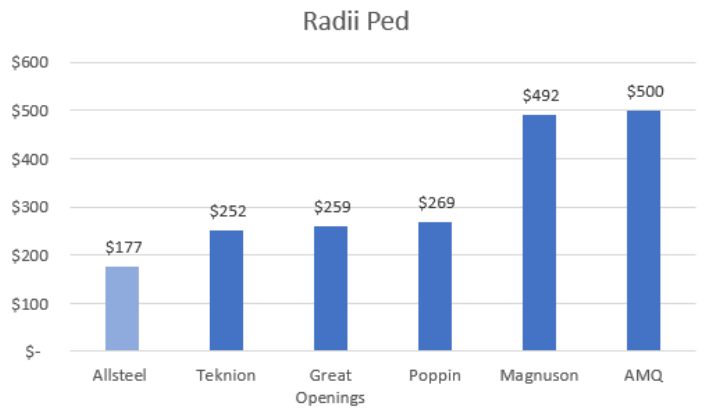
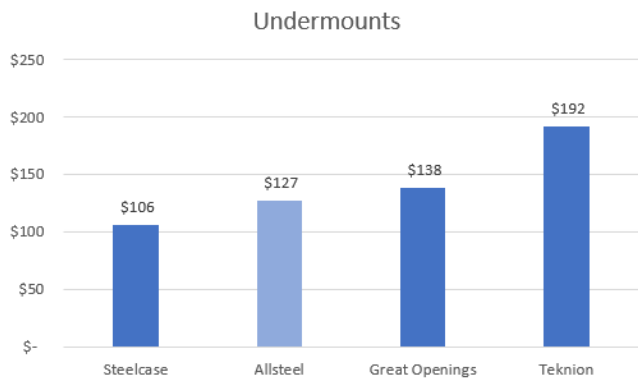
