

Task Lighting FAQ

Q: What task lights are new to the Allsteel offering?

A: WandFS and WANDFSOC are existing Allsteel Task Light models, we have since expanded the Wand Light offering by adding a USB charging model. Splitty Task Light has also been added to round out the offering with more finish options, two mounting alternatives, and device charging.

Q: How does the Splitty Task Light offer teleconferencing benefits?

A: The 360-degree light head swivel and soft-touch dimming features allow for users to angle the task light above a laptop to illuminate the user for optimal teleconferencing lighting.

Q: What finish options are available?

A: Wand Task Lights are available in silver and white. Splitty Task Lights are available in silver, white, and matte black. Accessories are available in silver only. Paint finishes are not HNI color matched.

Q: What would you recommend as a substitute for the discontinued Link Light?

A: The Splitty Task Light offers freestanding, clamp mount, and slat wall mount base options. These features align with the Link light offering and exceed the offering with features like USB charging, expanded finish offerings, and soft touch dimming.

Q: Which task lights offer the occupancy sensor feature?

A: WANDFSOC and WANDFSUSB offer an occupancy sensor feature. These task lights will turn off after 15 minutes of inactivity. See instructions for details on how to engage OC features.

Q: Are Allsteel Task Lights GSA/TAA Compliant?

A: Yes, Allsteel Task Lights are GSA/TAA compliant. Splitty Accessory models are not.

Q: Which Task Lights offer USB ports?

A: WANDFSUSB offer USB-C & USB-A ports. Splitty offers a USB-A port.

Q: Do the task lights offer dimming capabilities?

A: WANDFSOC, WANDFSUSB, and Splitty all offer dimming capabilities by holding down the power buttons.
