Your safety is important, but you also have a duty of care to the other skiers on the slopes, no matter how good they are.

Here are the main ways to behave and act before lessons and on the

BEFORE/AFTER LESSONS

• Only use the skis and boots allocated to you.

- Never use anyone else's equipment. This can be very dangerous if you fall.
- Take good care of the equipment you are given, as you will have to pay for anything lost or damaged, and make sure it is returned to the proper place each evening.
- Unsupervised skiing is not permitted at any time during your trip.
- You must carry your EHIC or GHIC (Health Insurance Card) with you, especially on the slopes.

WHEN SKIING

- Be on time for all lessons!
- Listen carefully to your instructor.
- Encourage others who may be finding it more difficult.
- Look after your equipment especially at lunchtime.
 Leave it in a safe place that
 can be easily found before
 your afternoon ski lesson.
- In the event of a collision, the person behind is always held responsible.
- Familiarise yourself with the 10 FIS rules* as per our website.

USING THE CHAIRLIFTS

 Always make sure the safety bar on chairlifts is securely closed and note that any swinging of chairs is illegal and dangerous.
