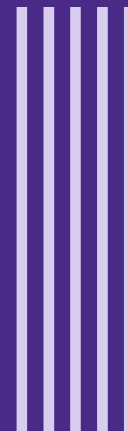




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Helpful Advice

Breakdown Cover

In the unlikely event that you breakdown call **RAC** on the number on the front of this book. Whilst they endeavour to attend the scene of any breakdown as soon as possible, naturally there are factors and elements outside of our control. They advise an estimated time of arrival which is circa 90 minutes, however their average attendance time is within 60 minutes.

The Camper is a VW T2 Camper GYT 280J. Spare wheel is in the rear bay.

In the event of you cancelling any assistance between informing them of your breakdown, and the point of their agent arriving on scene, or you are not present with the vehicle upon their arrival, you will be liable for a call out cancellation charge of £98.40.



Electric Hook Up

The electrical hook up cables are in the cupboard and the hook up point in the engine bay. This will enable the 13 Amp sockets and power the DVD, Cool box etc and charge the leisure battery.

Getting Started

What to bring:

ID: We will need to see your driving license and a proof of address not less than 3 months old please.

Bedding: Please bring your own bedding, towels, sleeping bags etc. We do have cushions and travel blankets on board.

What we include:

Cool box: The cool box has an electrical supply, so you can plug into the leisure battery. We will put frozen blocks in it before you go.

Gas: The tank is under the rear seat. Please turn off when not in use.

Water: You can use the clean water/waste water containers if you want to use the sink.

Carbon Monoxide sensor: Under the rear seat.

Fire: Extinguisher and Blanket are in the rear bay.

Camping table & Sun Canopy (pole and clips) are in the rear bay

A full tank of fuel – **please return full**

We will do a vehicle check together and agree 4 exterior and 4 interior photos

Note:

The camper is 2 metres high with the pop top down. Be careful!
