Kaitlyn Lusk kicks off her 20th year as the featured vocalist with Lord of the Rings Live in Toronto

January 18, 2023 - Kaitlyn Lusk will begin her 20th year touring with Lord of the Rings Live at Toronto's Meridian Hall January 27-29, 2023 as they perform The Lord of the Rings: The Fellowship of the Rings alongside Howard Shore's Academy Award-winning score being played live by 238 musicians.

As Kaitlyn Lusk continues into her 20th year as the featured vocalist in the Lord of the Rings Concert Series, she will begin her tour in North America with shows in Toronto, at New York City's Radio City Music Hall, Ottowa, and Montreal before heading to Europe.

About Lord of the Rings: Live:

In this concert series, J.R.R. Tolkien's Middle Earth is brought to life through Peter Jackson's beloved film projected on a giant screen alongside Howard Shore's Academy Award-winning score being played live by 238 musicians — including a symphony orchestra, and chorus with Lusk as the featured soloist and Ludwig Wicki as conductor.

Lusk made her debut at age 14 as the featured vocal soloist in the production since her debut at 14. Since then, the now mother of two, Lusk has continued her work with many of the world's finest orchestras with a variety of conductors, including Howard Shore. Mr. Shore invited Kaitlyn to perform the Academy Award-winning "Into The West" when he was honored by the Grammy's in New York City.

I think most little girls hope for that 'Cinderella moment,' and I feel very lucky that that moment happened to me when I was 14. I'm fortunate enough to still be living it. Now at 33, and a mom of two, my hope is for my kids to find a passion that they love as much as I love my own. I grew up with Lord of the Rings and still find new ways to appreciate the work every time I perform.
