The entire place is inspired by all things Bellport, especially with local artists featured throughout the inn. The Newmans, Ivana and John, closed on the property at the end of April. Since then, they lightly refreshed the building with white tones throughout, maintaining the integrity of the historic inn by also restoring as many of the antiques as possible.

The idea, owner Ivana Newman explained, was to create a relaxed experience at the historic property that dates back to 1889, once known as the Great South Bay Inn. The location neighbors Main Street, with quick access to all the village amenities, including the marina, Ho-Hum Beach and the country club.
