Blasting: It is forbidden and a serious offense, to enter forested areas during the last ascent, ski runs and snow tracks. Caution! No safety can be guaranteed for their own safety, people can get lost or die from detonation about blasting from slopes. Blasting in the area - risk of explosion.

chargeable offence to enter closed areas and walk or sledge off-ski routes are closed due to avalanche hazards. When there is a risk, tourists outside the safeguarded areas must take responsibility for their own safety. Please note that the snow is unstable in some areas. The ski runs are in operation. Do not cross below slope maintenance areas. These areas are restricted, in narrow passages, to the movement of snow removal equipment. Fresh snow: The Albermarle area receives fresh snow every day. However, when there is no snow on the ground, there is no snow to remove. At the same time, even with maximum snow removal equipment, there will be times when snow removal equipment cannot reach the bottom of the slope. In such cases, snow will remain on the bottom of the slope.
