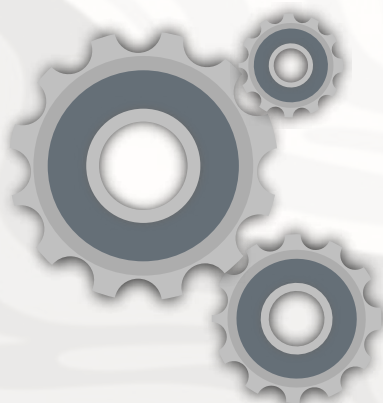


# Kindergarten

Students really like and enjoy the use of technology!



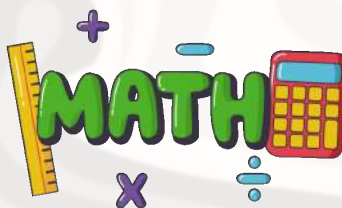


# Primary Science & Math Classes

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# Primary Science Class

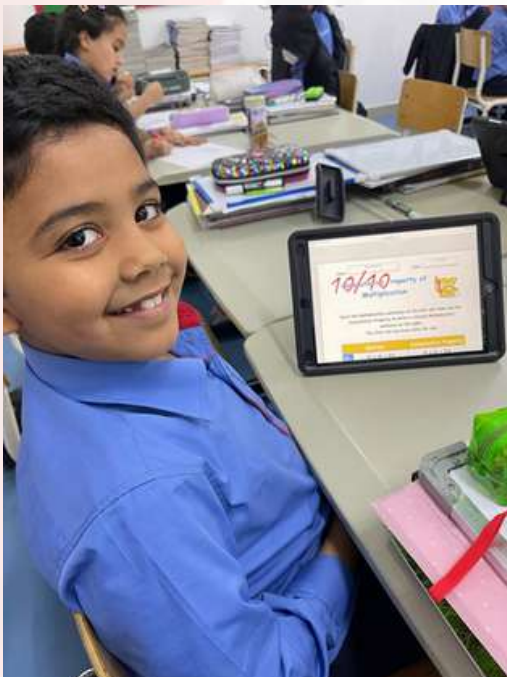

# Primary Math Class

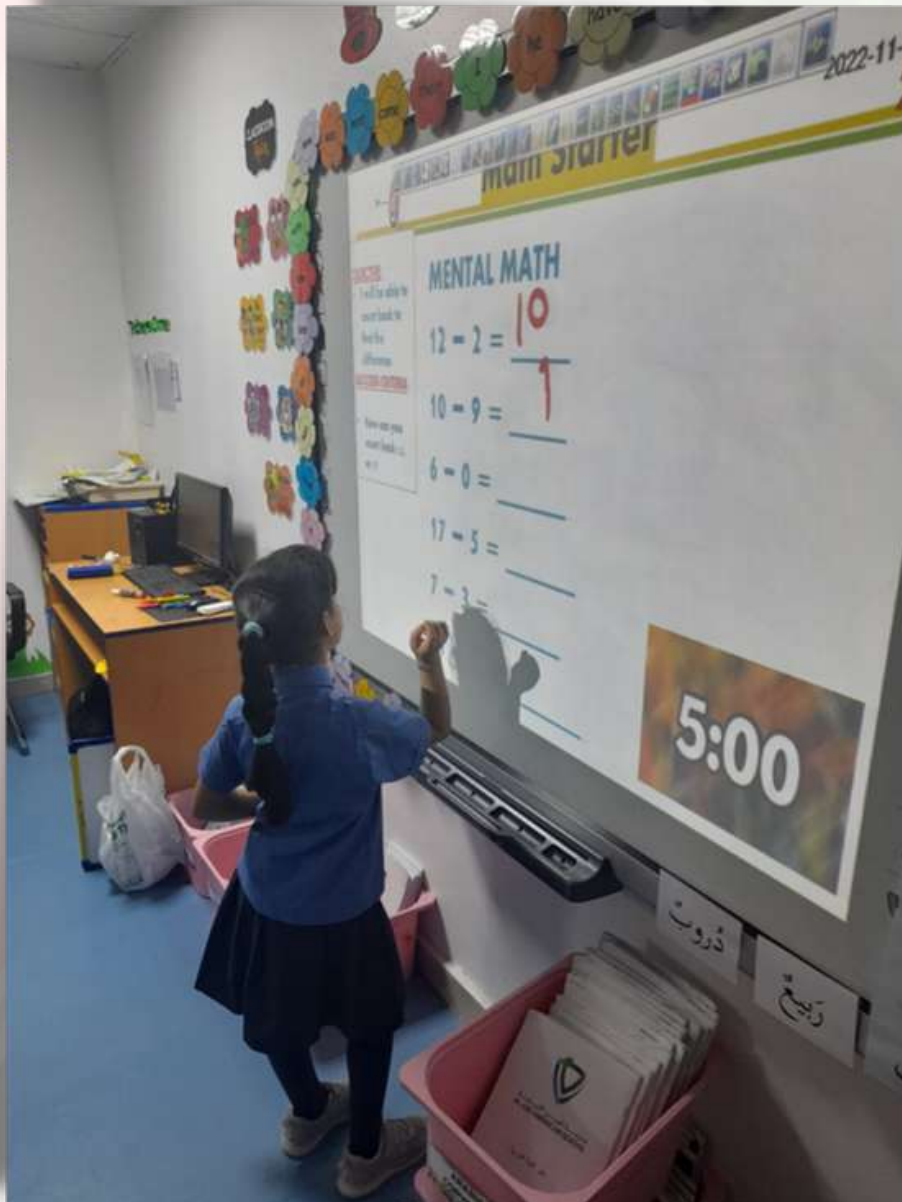

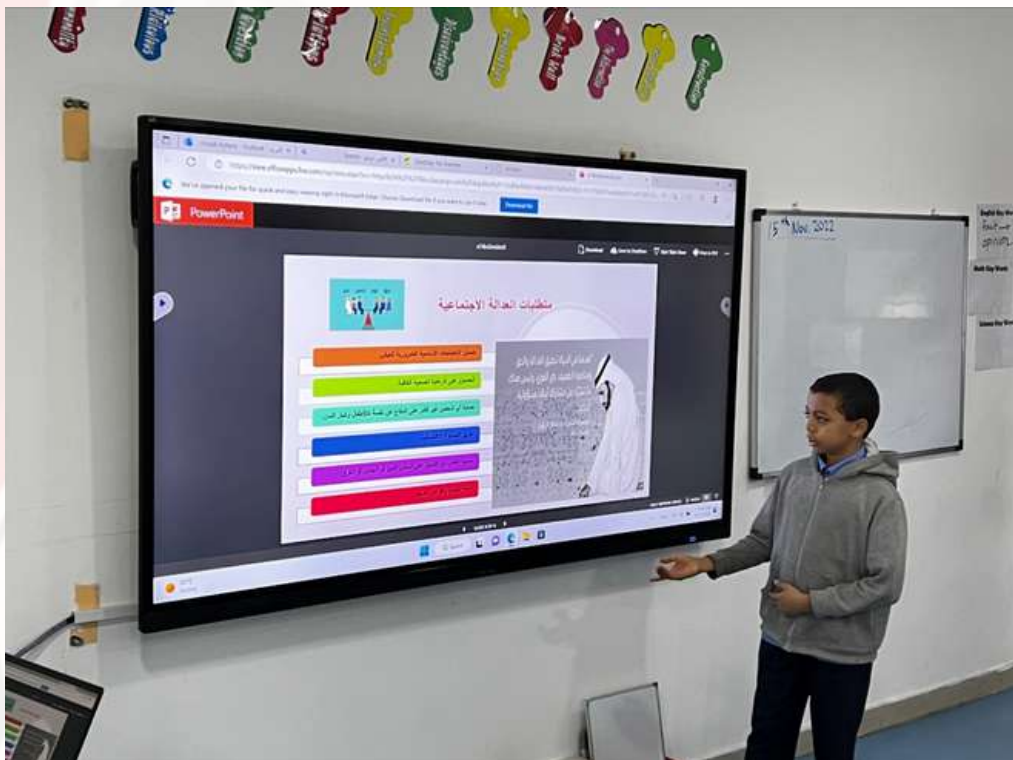
## TIMSS Alignments workshop

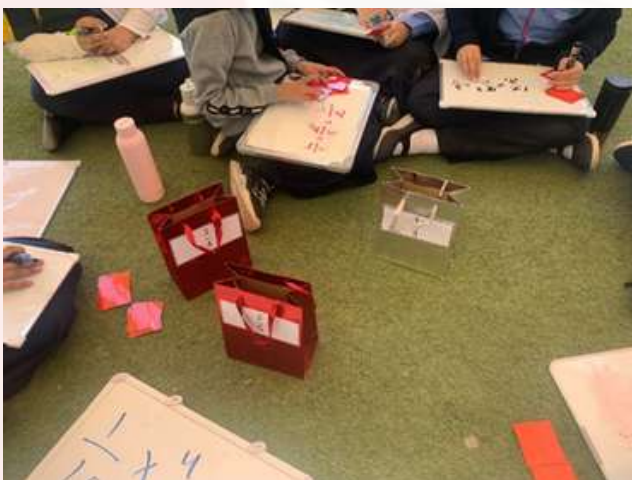


Fifth grade students enjoy solving various activities about the digestive system through the textbook and the Word Wall program

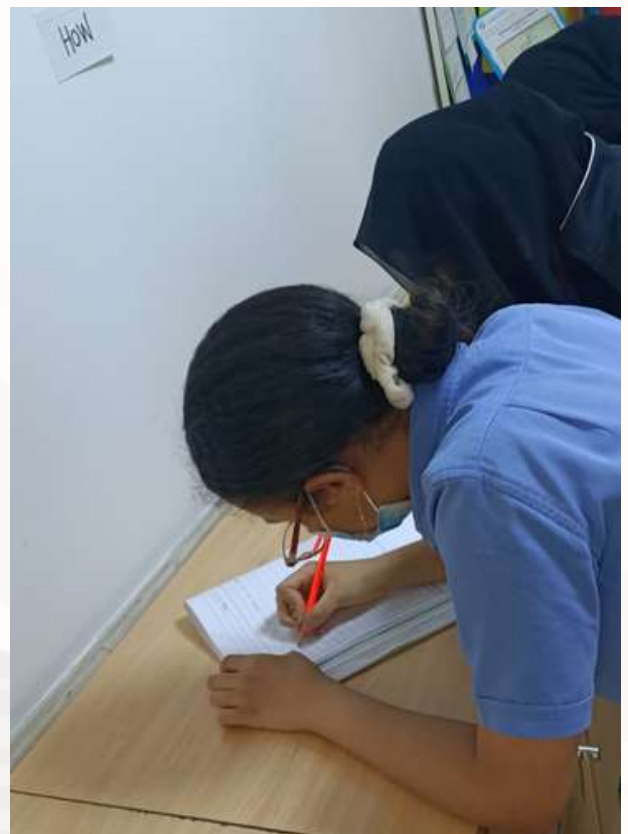
Relative Pronouns and Noun Clauses

How Students felt:

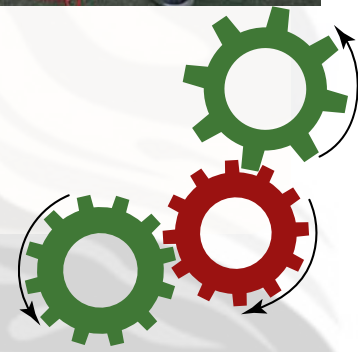
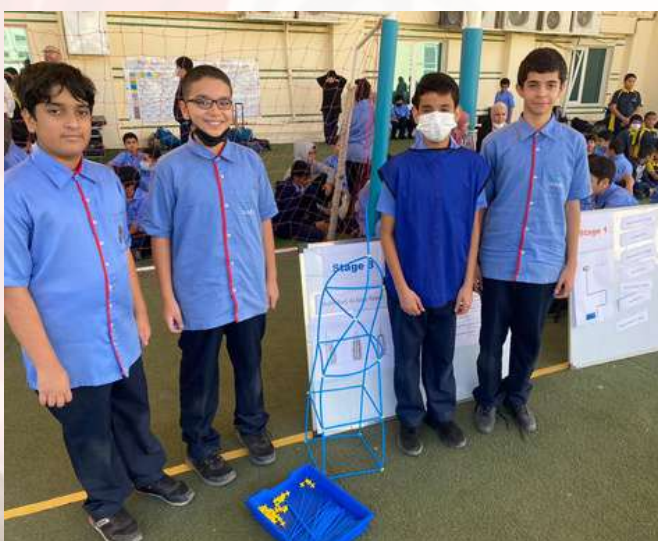
