Youth will participate in a 4-week skill development training program, followed by a 2-week work experience with participating employers.

We are looking for employers to:

- Provide youth with a 2-week employment opportunity for 30hrs/week

- Subsidized hourly rate equivalent to minimum wage
- Support the development of a young workforce in our community
- Youth will have ongoing support from the Yukon Literacy Coalition, Iilitaqsinig and NWT Literacy Council throughout the 2-week work placement
- Opportunity to retain employees beyond the 2-week work placement

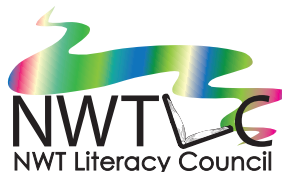
