We focus on improving access to safe water, adequate sanitation facilities, and good hygiene practices. Our activities include water supply and rehabilitation, construction of latrines, hygiene promotion, menstrual hygiene management, and community education to prevent waterborne diseases.

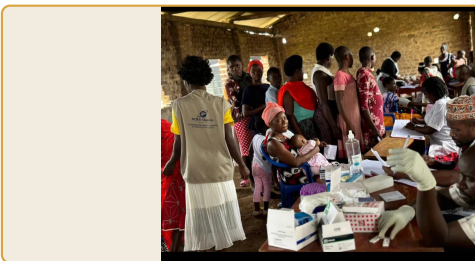
