2nd Building of Bacho Primary School is not done

Our reconstruction of Bacho Primary school continues to run on schedule. The workers in Tanzania finished the 2nd building (the one we, as volunteers, helped lay the foundations and start raising the walls). The project is already having a positive impact with school enrollment up by 23%. The principal at school expects this number to double once we complete the project. YAY!!!!





Classes now being given in the remaining old building will be moved to this new one so we can demolish the remaining old building and start the final phase of the project: the construction of the 3rd (and final) building followed by kitchen and toilets. We continue to except completion of the 3rd building by the end of the year and the toilets and kitchen within 1Q2018 (before the next rainy season).

It is exciting to see such a nice and beautiful new school and the positive impact it is already having. Once again, thank you all for making this project possible!

As some of you already heard, we have started to fundraise for our 2018 projects which will focus on bringing clean water and sanitation to Gajal and Haysam - two large areas not too far from Bacho. In the next few weeks, I hope to contact everyone with more details of these projects.
