

Approx. 15,000 people have now clean water & Students' bathrooms at Ayalagaya Secondary School are done!

Dear Karimu supporter,

These wonderful pictures of clean water flowing in Gajal, Haysam, and Dareda Kati are "fresh out of the oven". The project to bring clean water to all 15,000 people of these three areas is now fully functional. Sixty-five water points are already operational across the areas and we are adding the remaining 28 with completion planned before Christmas.

No household in the whole region will be further than 500m from a water point, reducing dramatically the time needed to fetch water. Because addressing the water needs of a Tanzanian family is the chore of the kids, they will now be able to fulfill their family obligation and still go to school.



Additionally, both Gajal and Haysam Primary Schools have now clean water. Their students no longer need to waste learning time fetching water for the school.



Finally, we finished the construction of the students bathroom at Ayalagaya Secondary School. I get tears of happiness looking at the before and after pictures.
