We just finished analyzing the 2018 data from the schools of Ayalagaya Ward (the region Karimu has been operating). The results are impressive:

- all schools are now feeding their students
- attendance rate is almost reaching our goal of >90% in all schools
- all schools improved the percentage of students passing the National Exam with some increasing the rate by over 50%

While we cannot directly correlate such success to Karimu's investments in education, we can clearly see that our schools are performing significantly higher than the schools in areas where we haven't yet invested. In average, our schools perform at least 20% higher.

In any case, we are very proud of our schools!
