In case you don't receive our <u>Annual Founders' Newsletter</u> in the mail, we want to make sure you know that the owners of Quantaphy, a Santa Cruz, California, company, are offering a \$30,000 matching grant to help build new bathrooms for Endasago Primary School. The need is urgent because Tanzania's central government is threatening to close the school because its unsanitary toilets pose a health hazard.

Quantaphy's grant, if matched, will also help to supply Dareda Kati Health Center with a radiology lab, a pharmacy, and isolation for patients suffering from contagious diseases.
