Dear Karimu Friends and Donors

I am so excited (and proud) of the latest news from Tanzania and I felt the urge to share it with you.

This week the Dareda Kati Dispensary started to operate fully computerized. With the support of the government, we bought computers and printers and installed an IT system that manages the registration of patients, collection of their vital signs and issues, results of the doctor consultation, prescriptions, etc. in addition to managing the clinic inventory and producing all kinds of important reports automatically.



Looking back, I am amazed with how far we managed to come in such a short period of time. In 2016, Dareda Kati still had its old dispensary which Karimu helped improve over the years:



Then, in 2017, the government opened the new dispensary that was built by Karimu.



2018 was all about making it operational, donating medicine, equipment, training the medical staff ...

Then, in 2019, 3 volunteer doctors spent 2 weeks working next to the staff,



we installed electricity, and provided a 6 month long training on how to use computers to every member of the medical staff.



They graduated in March of this year, enabling us to finally dramatically improve the operations and, with that, the quality of services provided to the whole community.

I am thrilled!

Thank you VERY much for all your support throughout this journey. It does pay off.
