Candid (GuideStar) is the world's largest source of information about nonprofits, supplying data on 2.7 million tax-exempt organizations. Their Platinum Seal of Transparency affirms that Karimu regularly makes public, at the highest level of transparency, vital information about goals and strategies, as well as progress indicators that highlight our impact in the communities we serve. The Platinum Seal of Transparency also affirms our fiscal solidity. We anticipate similar recognition by Candid's competitor, Charity Navigator, once the latter has finished reviewing our 2023 IRS return, filed this past June.

Candid's (Guidestar) recognition underscores Karimu's conviction that our donors deserve to know exactly how we spend their money.
