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# How to Create Your Own Computer Green Screen Clip

## Why You May Want to Do This

- You can put in an image that represents a course, live streaming, speaking engagement, internet, etc. to make it look original.
- You can add this as a clip to your marketing video teaser
  - Add to timeline (video tutorial coming next week)
  - Key out the green part and whatever clip you put underneath it will show as if it was appearing on your computer screen (whether a still frame or a video)



# Creative Uses in Your Video

**You can drag and drop this image into your video software editing timeline**

- The Done For You Clips can be used and repurposed for other content in the future.
- For this marketing video, be creative. You can use them:
  - To Represent an Online Course
  - To Represent Facebook Lives
  - Zoom Calls (Live Strategy Sessions/Mentoring with You and/or Other Experts)
  - Membership Sites
  - Online Templates
  - Website
  - Creative Talking Piece or Visuals (to keep your video moving next to still text descriptions of course content).



# How To Create

## Your Own Green Screen Computer Clip

- Download the Image You Want from <https://pixabay.com/>
- In the search bar put in “computer screen”
  - You can get done for you clips (see right and next slide)
  - You can create your own templates (see next few slides)
  - If you want to narrow the search, click on the drop down menu and choose images, vectors or photos depending on what you want.
- On the next page, I give you samples with links and then step by step how to create it. You will also get 3 Done-For-You Clips to choose from to insert into your video timeline if you want to use them so don't worry.


- Green screen and blue screen clips are interchangeable. They will work with your keyer in your editing software, background remover or instant alpha.



# Step by Step Tutorial

## STEP 1:

Download Image and drag to document, keynote, powerpoint, picture editing software or video timeline. If it's a white background instead of instant alpha, then background remove the computer screen portion only.



## STEP 2:

Insert a Rectangular Shape and Arrange it so it is the full size of the computer screen You will have to change the color of the shape to green.



## STEP 3:

Arrange it so it is behind the computer screen. Scale and position it so it fits the size of the computer.





## STEP 4:


Save as a PDF then Open PDF and Export and Save as a PNG. PDF's can be dragged into a Final Cut Pro X timeline so you can skip the step to convert to png if you use that software but you may need this step for some other creative hack in the future.


