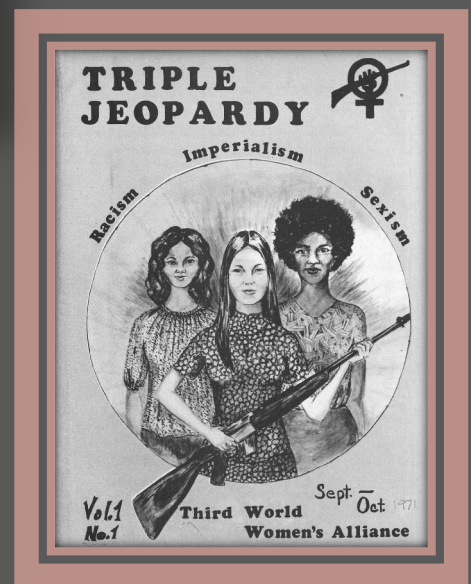

This presentation examines North Korean women's interaction with other Asian women within network of anti-imperial women's internationalism, focusing on – but not limited to – the Women's International Democratic Federation (WIDF). Drawing on *Chosun Women*, the organizational magazine of the Korean Democratic Women's Union (KDWU) founded and led by Park Choeng-ae, this presentation traces transnational women's connections, particularly in the region of Asia in the early Cold War period and situates them within the emerging context of the Third World's non-aligned movement. This study highlights the gendered dimensions of anti-imperialist and socialist nation-building from the perspective of women's organizations.
