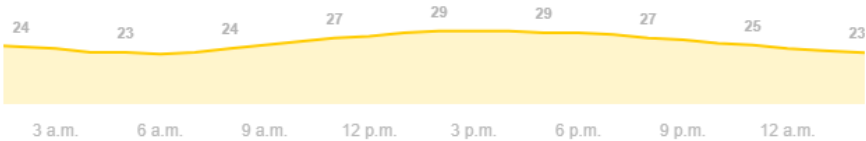

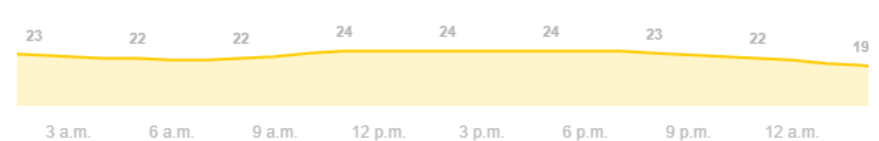

 - MPE 309504

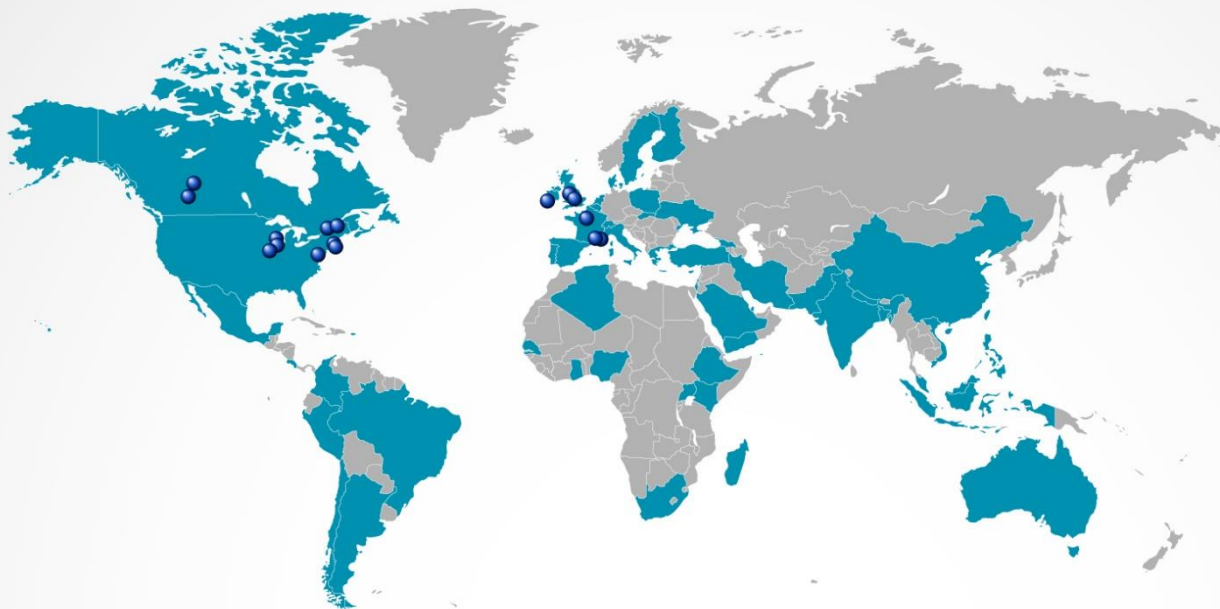
