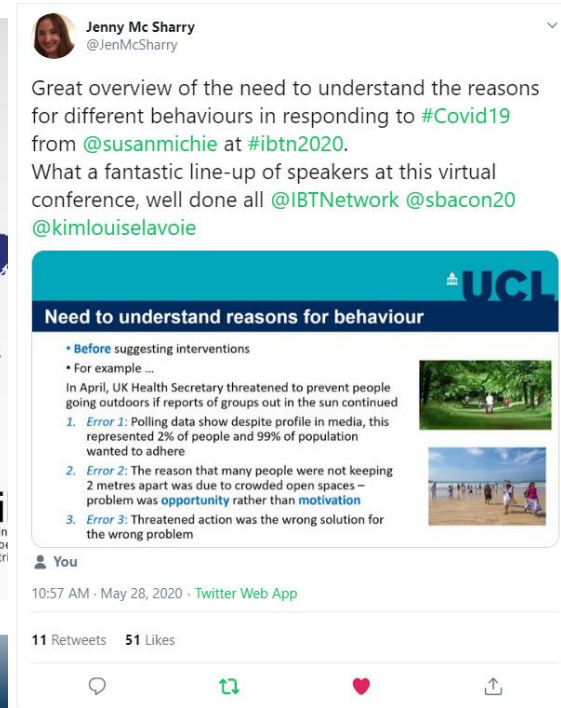

# #IBTN2020 – Day 1 highlights

**Pathways to SARS-CoV-2 transmission: the behaviours and measures to block them**

Large circles = stages in the pathway.  
Red arrows = routes of transmission.  
Crosses in small circles = blocks.  
Rectangles = behaviours to block transmission routes (red borders = final transmission route).  
Dotted arrows point to the blocking points.
