The Intel® Edge Solutions Challenge (IESC) is an on-going series of time-bound campaigns designed to support and award Intel's ecosystem partners as they develop and deploy optimized solutions based on Intel® architecture and ingredients.

Does my company have to be a member of the Intel Partner Alliance (IPA)?

Do I have an ideal solution for IESC?

How do I submit a solution for consideration in IESC?

Start with the <u>IESC web site</u>. Register and create a user profile. Then you can submit a solution through the process of creating a project. The IESC web page will provide you with a project template that will enable you to submit the details of your solution for consideration.

How long will the challenge last?

Companies may submit projects from Mar 31, 2024 to October 15, 2024. Solutions that meet the hardware and software requirements will be reviewed by Intel and awards will be announced in January 2025.
