

Cookie Statement

We use cookies on our website. Cookies are small information files that are placed on your computer when visiting the website. When visiting our website for the first time, we will display a message explaining cookies. We will ask for your explicit consent to the use of cookies, to the extent we are obliged to.

Why do we use cookies?

Cookies allow a website to work properly and to understand visitor behaviour on the website. With this information, we can improve the web services and your user experience. Cookies do not compromise the security of your computer.

What type of cookies do we use?

We distinguish between the following types of cookies:

1. Functional cookies

Functional cookies are necessary for the proper functioning of the website or to ensure that you quickly and accurately receive the desired information during each visit. This is useful because it saves you having to re-enter your data, indicate your preferences or change your settings.

2. Non-functional cookies

Non-functional cookies inform us about the number of visitors to the website and how these visitors use the website. We can use this information to further improve the website. We also use these cookies to show you appropriate advertisements on other sites or to provide you with targeted offers. These files disappear automatically as soon as you close your internet browser or remain on your computer for up to 12 months after your last visit.

Analytical cookies are used to:

- improve the performance of the website by reducing the load time of the pages you visit. These data are collected anonymously.
- improve the user experience

Advertising cookies are used to:

send information to other websites based on which they can customise their advertising.

Social Media Cookies (Facebook, Google+, Twitter, Pinterest) are used to:

allow you to share and 'like' things.

Deletion of cookies

Cookies come in the form of session cookies or persistent cookies. Session cookies are deleted from your computer as soon as you close your web browser. Persistent cookies remain stored on your computer

until their expiry date. You can also manually delete these cookies from your computer at any time. Look under 'Internet Options' in your browser (the Help function in your browser may help you with this). You can read more about cookies and how to delete and check them on www.aboutcookies.org. Please note that disabling or deleting cookies may result in less optimal website performance.

Personal data

When setting certain cookies, personal data are collected as well. It describes, among other things, how you can request access to your data, correct or delete it, and how you can object to the use of your data.
