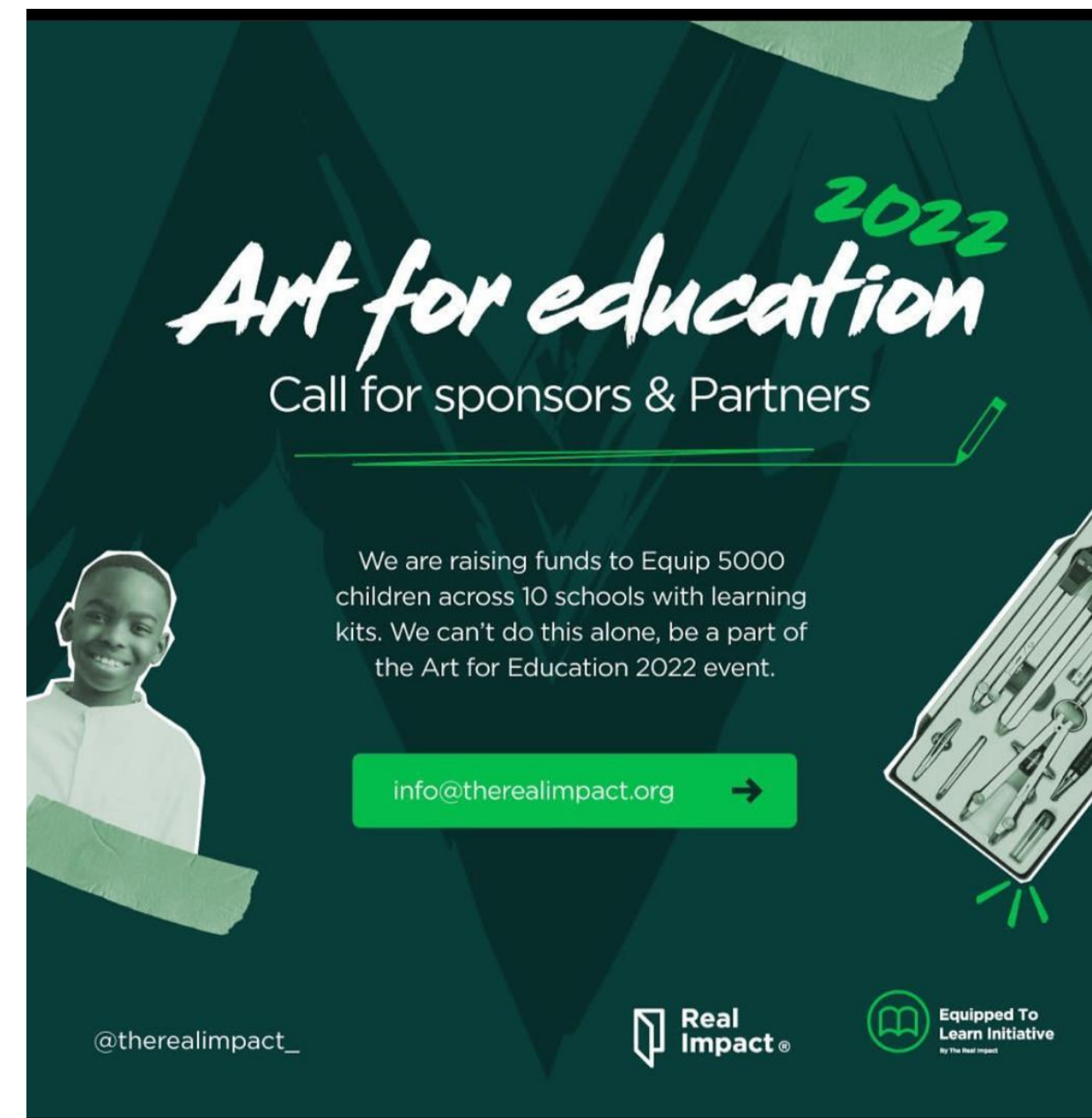


Marketing & Promotions
