

Cycle 11 Letter of Intent Instructions and Form

Cycle 11 of the Jeffrey Modell Foundation Translational Research Program is now open!

There is a two-step application process. A letter of Intent (LOI) is required and must be submitted in advance of submitting a full grant application.

Investigators who have submitted an LOI and have been invited by the JMCN Research Committee to submit a full grant application will be considered for funding.

To note: an invitation to submit a full grant application does not guarantee funding.

Letter of Intent Requirements

Please complete the attached LOI form. The LOI should provide a general overview of the proposed research project with sufficient detail to allow for the evaluation of the scientific merit and feasibility of the study.

Please submit your completed LOI form to <u>research@jmfworld.org</u> no later than Tuesday, March 14th, 2023.

Once submitted, a confirmation email will be provided. Investigators will be notified no later than Tuesday, May 9th, 2023 on whether they have been approved to submit a full grant application. For those invited to submit a full grant application, the deadline will be Thursday, July 6th, 2023.


