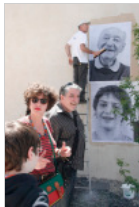
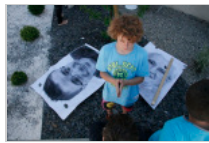
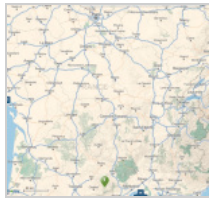


## JR in the Tarn
