

Examiner Recruitment Criteria (Financial Education)

The London Institute of Banking & Finance, a dynamic education provider with taught degree awarding powers, is seeking examiners for its Financial Education qualifications.

We would welcome interest from those keen to become an examiner at Level 2 and Level 3. Ideally, you will have a further education background either as an academic, or as a Financial Services industry practitioner with appropriate teaching or academic qualifications.

You will be educated to GCSE level or equivalent and have a minimum of 3 years' experience either teaching a similar Level 2 or Level 3 qualification (e.g. mathematics, economics or business studies) or you will have 3 years' industry experience.

The table below outlines the qualifications with current recruitment opportunities. All examining relates to the written part of the assessment methodology (case-study based).

Certificate in Financial Studies (CeFS) – QCF Level 3
Designed to provide students with a challenging qualification covering the core disciplines of financial capability, enabling them to examine issues relating to financial capability, apply specialised, current knowledge of financial capability and finance concepts and theories.
Diploma in Financial Studies (DipFS) – QCF Level 3
Designed to provide students with a challenging qualification covering the core disciplines of financial capability and financial sustainability as they impact on the individual, financial services sector and the government.
Certificate in Financial Education (CeFE) – QCF Level 2
Designed to prepare students to become responsible citizens by providing them with the skills and knowledge to manage their money well and make sound financial decisions. It also provides an understanding of the wider realm of public finance and the economy.
Technical Award in Finance (TAF) – QCF Level 1/2
Designed to provide students with a detailed introduction to the financial services sector, financial products and their application, and finance in business.
