

## (LEAD 3410) Leadership and Innovation

### Course Description

The purpose of this course is to study the synergy in innovation network teams by introducing various leadership styles and general traits of an innovation leader. Students will learn to carry out sustainable initiatives through collaboration, evaluation, and education. This course also assists in understanding how innovation leaders assess, clarify, and communicate an organization's culture and values, leading to both small and large-scale innovation success.

### Learning Objectives

By the end of this course, students will be able to:

- Evaluate how different leadership styles promote innovation within an organization.
- Analyze the impacts of effective followers on an innovation network team.
- Collaborate effectively with team members to foster innovation within an organization.
- Analyze the link between different approaches to innovation leadership.
- Analyze the factors that contribute to large and small innovation successes in the private sector and personal ventures.
- Devise innovative solutions to organizational problems, such as sustainable community management practices, by adapting lessons from leadership success stories.
