


The cart's compact footprint and top handles provide easy mobility. The Connect30 Cart is made with heavy-gauge steel for security and powder-coated for a durable, long-lasting finish. Locking door and panel increase security of the notebooks.









# Connect30 Device side view wiring diagram (shown without door)







