# VFI4 Visual Fault Identifier

The VFI4 is a visible red laser source designed to troubleshoot faults on fiber optic cables.



Warning! The VFI4 is a registered FDA Class IIIa/IEC Class 3R Laser Product. Never look directly into optical output!

## Inspecting Cables

Note: Clean connectors on cables before connecting them to VFI4!

- Attach the inspected cable to the 2.5 mm (or 1.25 mm) Universal adapter installed on the VFI4 optical port.
- When the VFI4 is Off to turn it On in either mode:
  - 2 Hz mode: Press and hold the On/Off button for 1.5 seconds
  - CW mode: Press and hold the On/Off button for 3 seconds
- Green LED will illuminate to indicate that VFI4 is on.
- Observe the inspected cable for faults.
- Press the On/Off button to turn the VFI4 off.

### **Replacing Battery**

- Remove the side battery door, then pull out the battery.
- Place the battery in the unit ensuring that the [+] and [-] poles correspond with the poles that are printed in the compartment.
- Replace the side battery door.

**Note:** The VFI4 contains no user serviceable parts. Except for changing batteries, this instrument must be returned to AFL for repair.

## **Cleaning Optical Output**

Use lint-free optical cleaning wipes such as AFL FiberWipes and optical quality cleaning fluid such as AFL FCC2 connector cleaning fluid.

### Warranty

All AFL's products are warranted against defective material and workmanship for a period of one year from the date of shipment to the original customer. Any product found to be defective within the warranty period will be repaired or replaced by AFL.
