




# Agility Table Assembly Diagram

READ THROUGH INSTRUCTIONS FROM BEGINNING TO END BEFORE STARTING TO ASSEMBLE UNIT.

- 1.) Identify and Separate all the Parts and Hardware.
- 2.) Lay Table Top (P-1) on Smooth surface as shown in illustration #1.



3.) Lift the legs, shelf and back panel assembly up vertical to the table top as shown in Illustration #2.



4.) Swivel the legs out and place them over the two locator posts that are attached to the bottom of the table top as shown in Illustration #3. Secure the leg to the table top using two Thumb Screws (C).



5.) Screw in two Locking Casters (A)) into the front threaded inserts in the legs as shown in Illustration #4. Screw in two Non-Locking Casters (B) into the rear threaded inserts. Tighten casters using Caster Wrench (D).



6.) Fold the shelf panel down and hook it on the shelf support tabs on each leg as shown in Illustration #5.


