



Assembly Diagram


READ THROUGH INSTRUCTIONS FROM BEGINNING

TO END BEFORE STARTING TO ASSEMBLE UNIT.

- 1.) Identify and Separate all the Parts and Hardware.
- 2.) Place the Top Panel (P-1) upside down on a padded surface. Attach a Leg (P-2) to the Top Panel (P-1) using two Screws (A) as shown in Illustration #1. Attach the second Leg (P-2) on the opposite side of the Top Panel (P-1) using two more Screws (A). Finger tighten only these Screws at this time.



3.) Place the Modesty Panel (P-3) between the Legs (P-2) and attach it using four Screws (A) as shown in Illustration #2. Tighten all Srews (A) using Allen Wrench (C)



4.) Place a Caster Lock Washer (D) on each caster stem and screw in two Locking Casters (B1) into the leg's front holes and two Non-Locking Casters (B2) into the leg's rear holes as shown in Illustration #3. Tighten casters using Caster Wrench (E).
