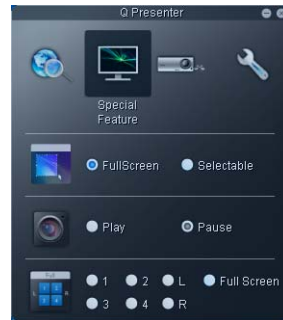

Using QPresenter



- To play sound through the projector speaker, simply click Activate audio out.

 Mac version of the QPresenter does not support this function.

- To display a partial screen, click Selectable. A square appears on your screen. You can adjust its size and place it where you want to project.

5. SYSTEM SETUP Advanced menu Reset All Settings	Returns all settings to the factory preset values.  The following settings will still remain: Phase, H. Size, User 1, User 2, Color Space Conversion, Language, Projector Position, High Altitude Mode, Security Settings, DHCP, SSID, Remote Desktop, Baud Rate and Remote Receiver.
