## Note

All thermal imagers require appropriate warm-up time in order to obtain the most accurate temperature measurement. This time can often vary by model and by environmental conditions. Although most imagers are fully warmed-up within 3-5 minutes, it is always a best practice to wait at least 10 minutes if the most accurate temperature measurement is critical to your application. Whenever changing or adding optional lenses, additional stabilization time may be required depending on the situation.
