Welcome to HOBOMobile. ## System Requirements

- Device with Android 5.0, 5.1, 6.0.1, or 7.0 and Bluetooth 4.0

## Notes

### Viewing Devices

- When leaving the HOBOMobile app while on the HOBOS screen, the screen could be blank upon return. Visit another screen, such as Data Files or Settings, and then return to the HOBOS screen. This will allow the screen to be redrawn correctly.
- Please do not turn off Bluetooth while using the HOBOMobile app as it is critical for displaying the accurate state of in-range devices.
- If you are having difficulty connecting to a device or performing a readout, close HOBOMobile and then turn off Bluetooth. Reopen HOBOMobile and enable Bluetooth when prompted. This may correct any connection issue being experienced.

**Reading Out Devices**

- After a successful readout on an MX2001 logger that is logging, stopping the logger and then attempting to read out the same data again may fail. Make sure the logger is completely disconnected by switching to another screen in HOBOMobile or shutting down HOBOMobile altogether. You should then be able to reconnect to the logger and read it out again.

**Sharing Data Files**

- When sharing data files, be sure to confirm that all your data arrived as expected before deleting any files in HOBOMobile.
- When selecting multiple data files for sharing by email, consider that your email server may have limitations on attachment size. After sharing your data files, be sure to confirm your email is received. If it is not, then you likely exceeded the attachment size limit. Go back and select fewer files and attempt the share again.
- When sharing .hobo files, you will need HOBOWare® 3.7 on the destination system to open these files. Note that versions prior to 3.7 will not properly open these files.
- When viewing a .hobo file from a configuration with Burst settings, the Burst settings may display in the Details pane as Alarm settings.
- If you would like to email data files or images from HOBOMobile, set up your mail account information before attempting to share these files. Mail account information can be entered in your device's Settings > Mail, Contacts, Calendars.
- When sharing a CSV file from a locale with a comma for the decimal separator, the decimal separator may incorrectly generate additional columns depending on the system in which you open this CSV file.
- When sharing an XLSX file from a configuration with Statistics Only logging mode, any Alarm settings will not be included in the Details sheet.
